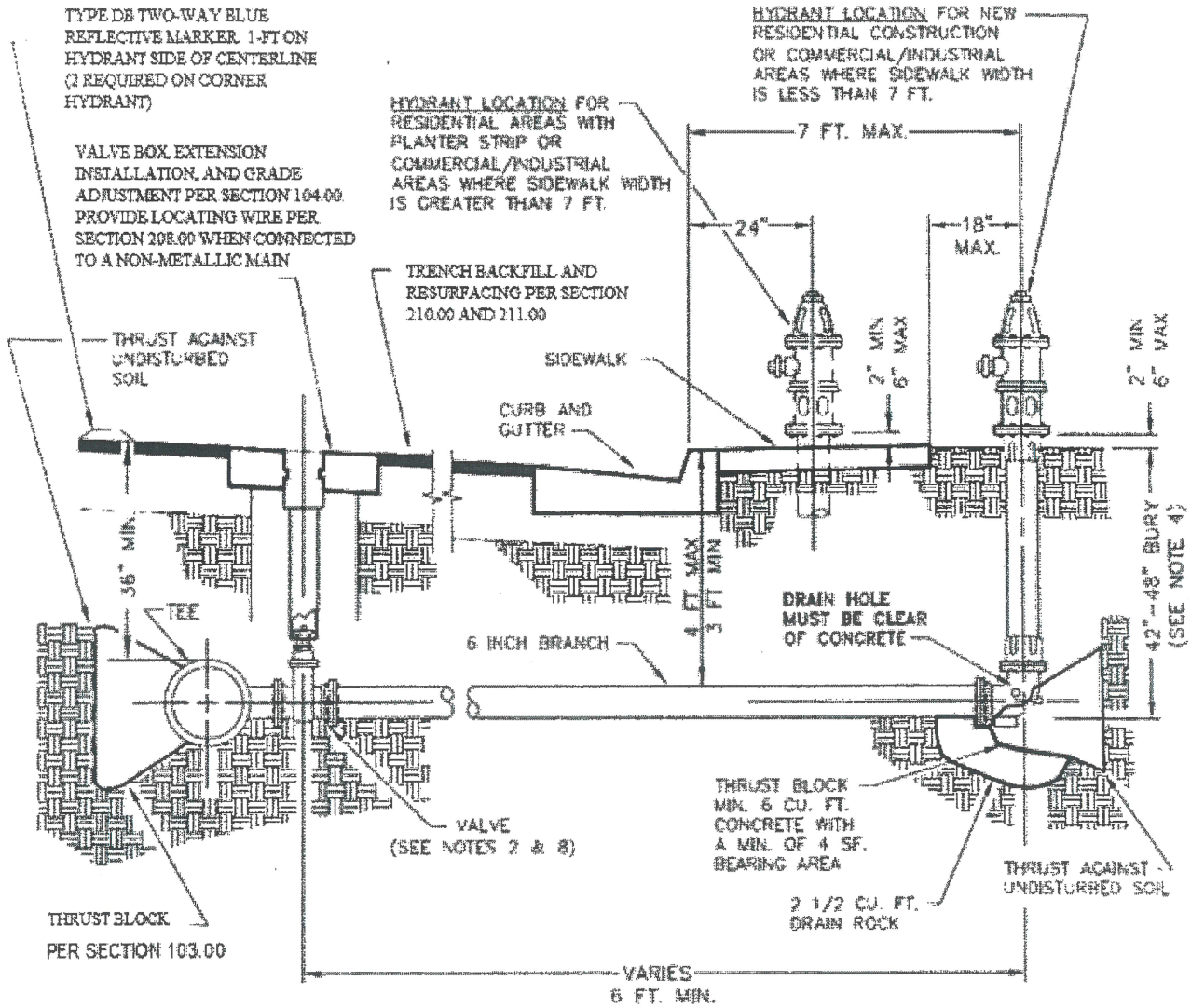


SECTION 121.00

FIRE HYDRANT INSTALLATION



NOTES:

1. All construction shall be in accordance with the District's Construction Standards.
2. For allowable fire hydrants, valves, pipes, and fittings, see materials list Section 100.00.
3. For hot tap requirements see Section 100.70.
4. Hydrant bury depth may vary with prior approval of the District's Engineer.
5. Hydrant shall be covered with an approved bag until accepted and placed in service.
6. A minimum distance of 3 ft shall be clear of all vegetation and other obstructions around the fire hydrant, per Uniform Fire Code Section 10.206.
7. No underground utility shall be located within 48" each side of fire service trench.
8. No primary electric vault, above-ground electric service cabinet, or street light shall be installed within seven (7) ft of the fire hydrant. Where restrained-joint fittings are used, which eliminates the need for a thrust block, this distance may be reduced to three (3) feet.

9. Hydrant valve shall be connected to water main by flanged joint.
10. Contractor shall provide bollards as directed by the District, City of Redding, Shasta County or associated Fire authorities.
