Board of Director's Meeting July 20, 2016



Adoption of Resolution 2016-08, Capital Budget for FY 2016-17: The Board of Directors unanimously adopted Resolution 2016-08, approving a balanced Capital Budget in the amount of \$376,230. This budget includes funds related to the Water Treatment Plant's Backwash Recycle Project, as well as the construction of an ADA Restroom Retrofit at the District Office.

Here are few reminders of how to conserve water during this hot summer...

- 1) Use soaker hoses on your plants. Go even further and place the soaker hoses on timers.
- 2) Clean vegetables in a basin of water with a brush, instead of under running water.
- 3) Filling the washing machine for each load, saves water and energy.
- 4) Use mulch around trees and plants to keep water from evaporating.
- 5) Capture the running water while waiting for the shower to warm up, and use this water in your household plants or garden.
- 6) Limit your outdoor watering to three days per week.
