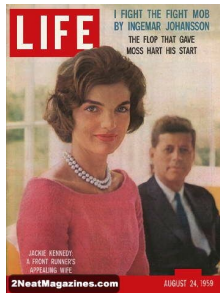

When we look at vintage cars, old pictures in magazines or reflect on how things used to be in the good old days, we never think about the pipes that deliver our drinking water.



Did you know that the District was formed in 1959? This means that some of the original infrastructure is now 58 years old and is approaching its useful service life.

Back in the mid 1960's a significant expansion of the distribution system was constructed. Being about 53 years old it will be necessary to plan for its replacement sometime within the next 22 years.

Part of having a successful water system is to plan ahead for the replacement of old infrastructure and future demands all while ensuring that a reliable and adequate supply of high quality water is provided to you at the lowest reasonable price, in an environmentally responsible manner.



Together we will continue to plan for a safe and reliable water system for both today and into the future.

E-Bills and Payments

Are you tired of snail mail? Would you like to receive your bill via email? There are two ways to begin receiving your monthly invoice via email:

1. Call the District Office and give us your email information.
2. Register your account at www.centervillecsd.org and sign up there.

Registering your account is easy and it allows you to review your account history, make a payment, go paperless, as well as request a service call.

ACH Payments

Are you tired of late fees? While you have the option to make online payments using a debit or credit card, it will cost you an additional \$3.00 or 3% whichever is greater. However, there is no additional cost to make an ACH Payment. Please stop by the District Office today and sign up for ACH Payments. You only need a voided check. We will automatically deduct your monthly payment from your checking account on the 15th of each month. No cost, no penalties...simply easy.

Practice the 4 D's

- ✓ DRAIN standing water
- ✓ DUSK & DAWN avoid outdoor activities
- ✓ DRESS wear long sleeves and pants during dawn and dusk
- ✓ DEFEND wear insect repellent

A handful of water can produce hundreds of mosquitoes. Neglected pools can produce more than a million mosquitoes and may affect people as far away as five miles.
